What is the “TXT Collector” program?

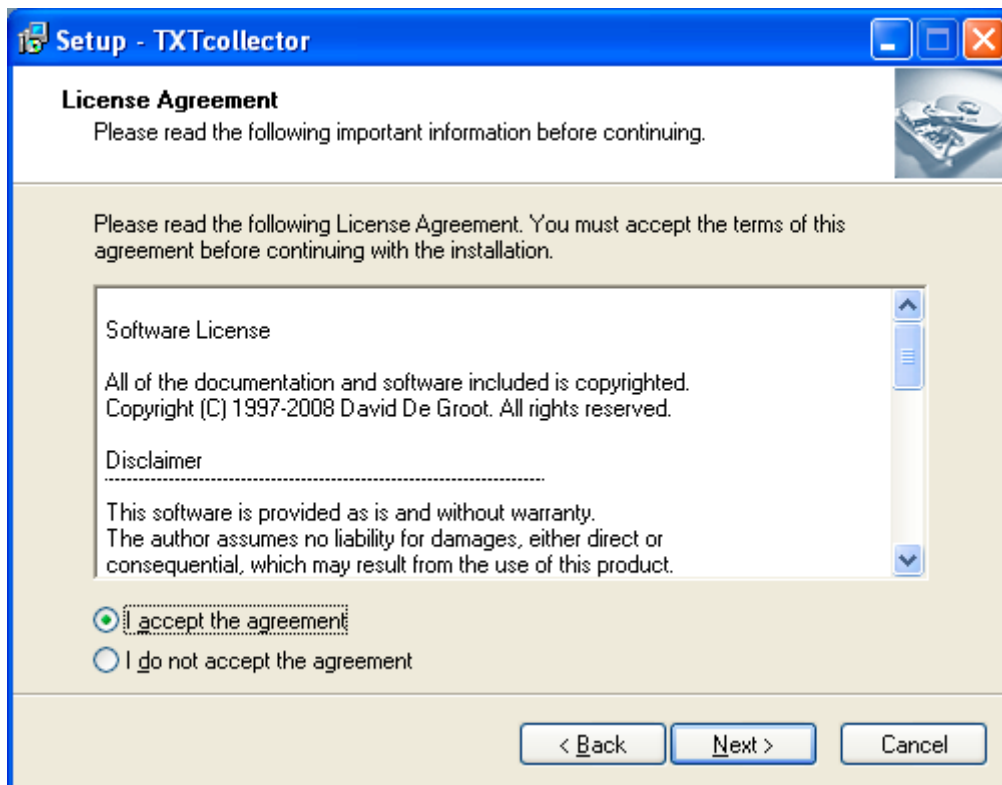
The Ibox/Eko21N-ip datalogger system collects data and sends it to an online server. The number of files can get quite large after an amount of time. To be able to easily process the collected data it can be very handy to have all data in one big data file. This easy to use program will combine all the collected datafiles in one big datafile. The data will be chronological order!

Installing the “TXT Collector” program

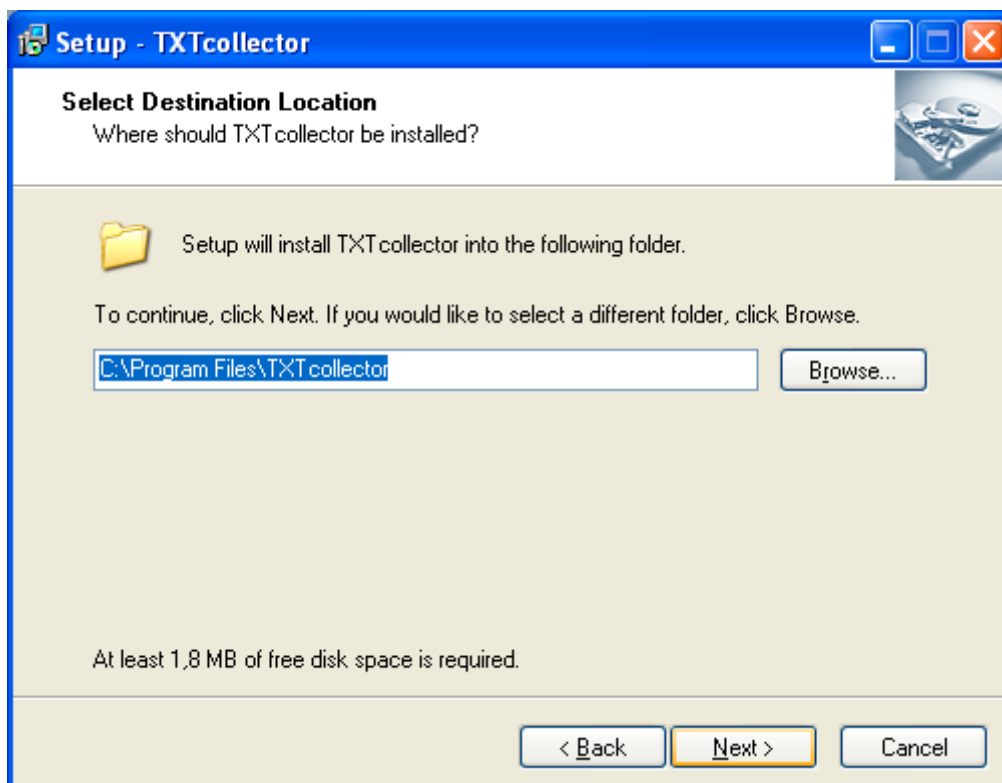
Double click the *setup.exe* file. Installation will start. Follow the next instructions.



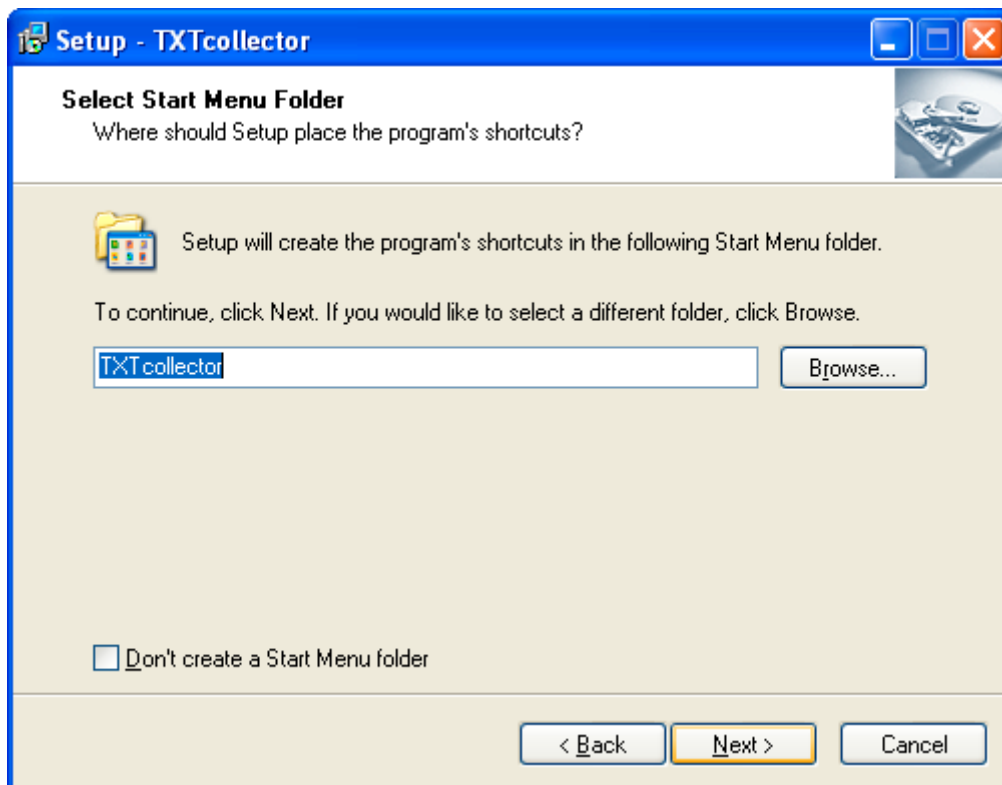
Press the *Next* button.



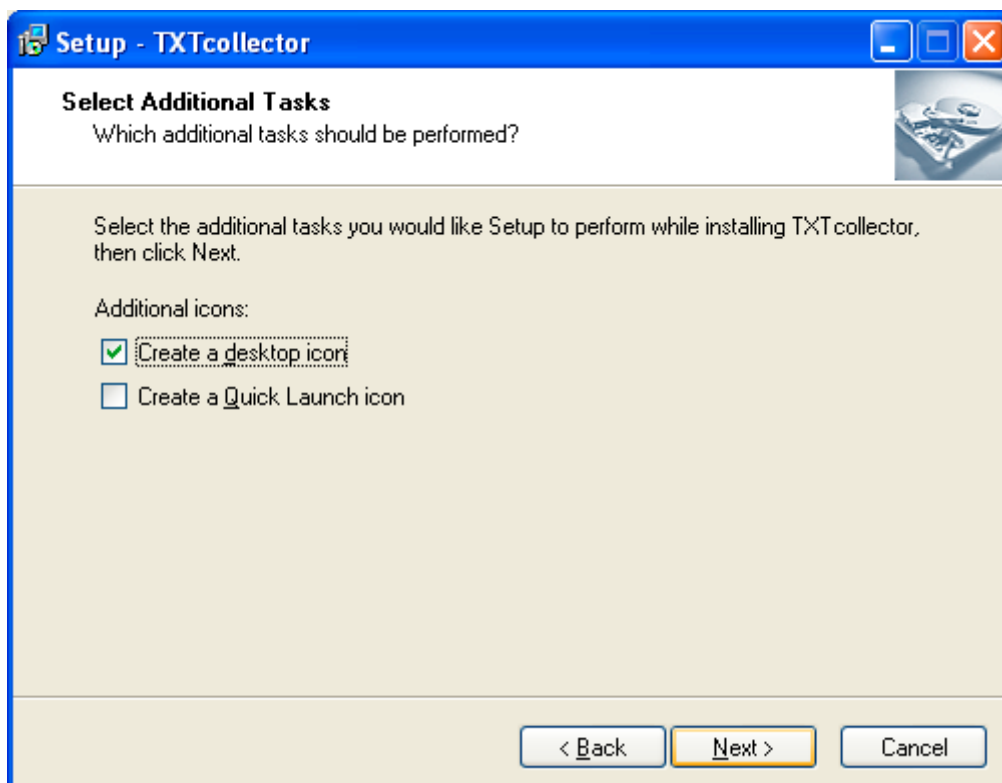
Select the *I accept the agreement* option and press *Next*.



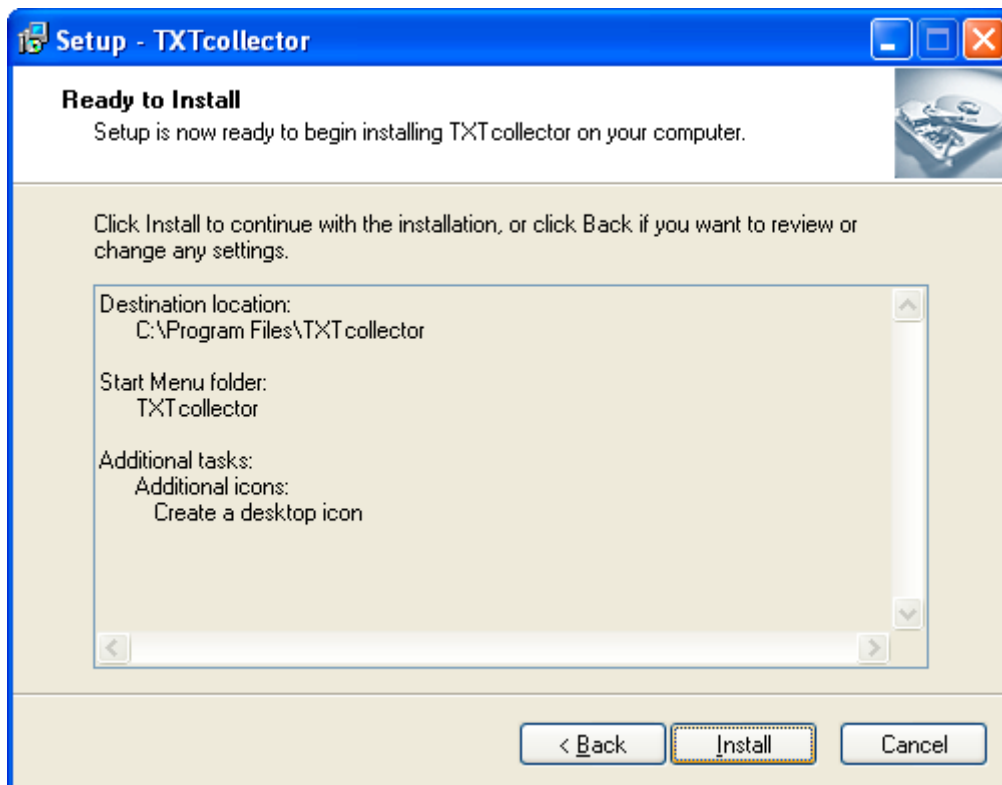
Select a folder where the program is to be installed by pressing *browse* or accept the default folder and press *Next*.



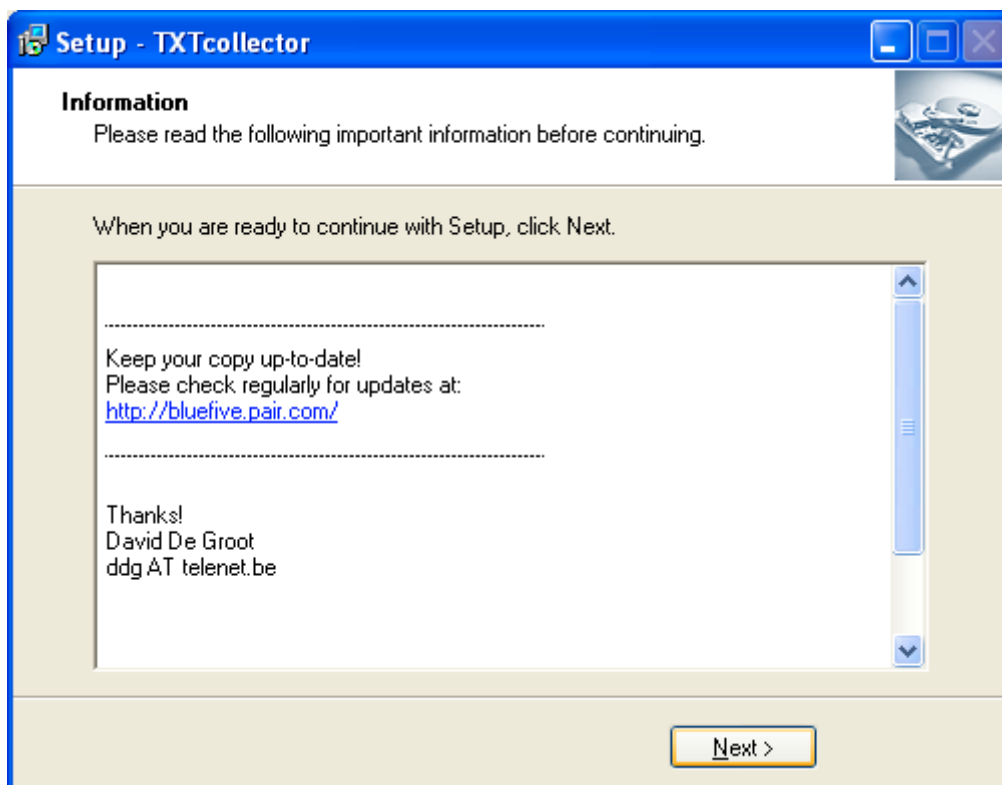
Press the *Next* button to accept the default program name in the Start Menu.



Select the *Create a desktop icon* and/or *Create a Quick Launch icon* options and press the *Next* button to continue.



The setup program is now ready to install the software, press the *Install* button to do so.

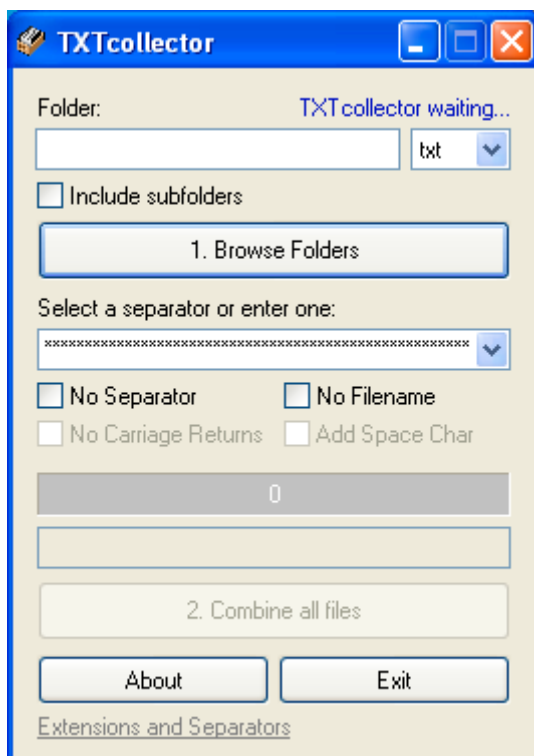


Press the *Next* button to continue.

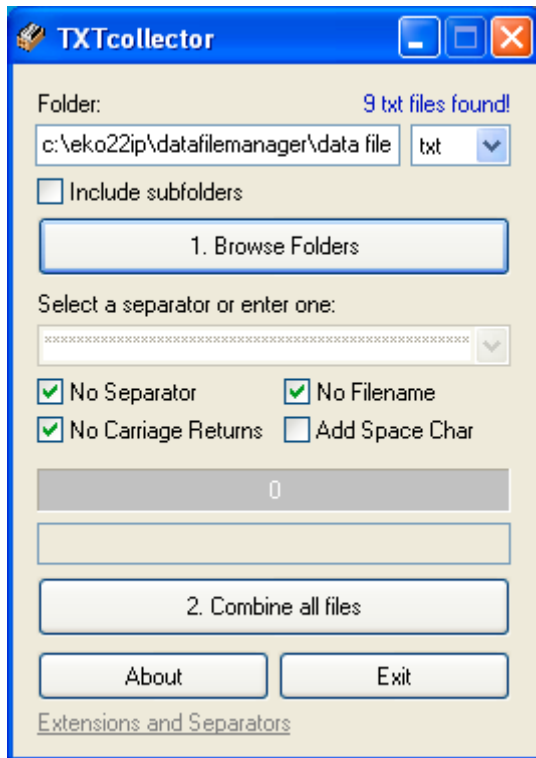


Install of the software is now finished. Press the *Finish* button.

Using the “TXT Collector” program.



When you first start the program there are a small number of setting you have to make.



Select the *txt* file name extension.

Select the *No Separator*, *No Filename*, *No Carriage Returns* options.

Press the *1. Browse Folders* button to select your datafile folder.

Press the *2. Combine all files* button to start combining the files.

After combining you will be prompted for a filename and folder where to put the datafile.
